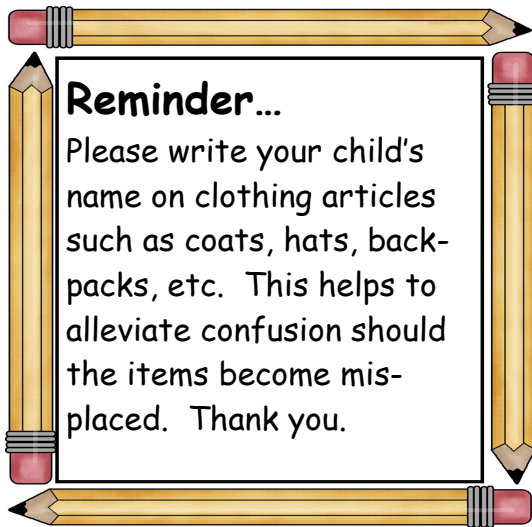
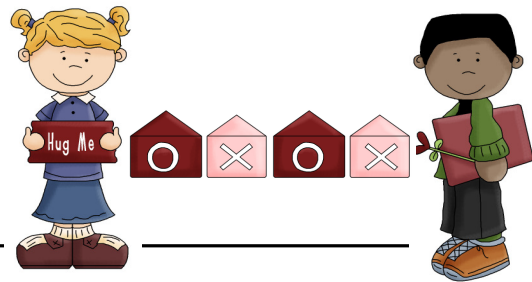
Parent/Child Make & Take Game with Valentine Activities
